Once again this year, we will be collecting toys and sports equipment for our mission partner, **Door of Hope** and their children and youth. The **Door of Hope** Christmas Fair comes EARLY this year, so we basically have the rest of this month of November to do our purchasing. **All unwrapped gifts need to be into the church by Friday, December 5.**

Door of Hope is one of the only homeless providers that can shelter any kind of family together in their own private unit, including single moms, single dads and two-parent families together with their children.

The gifts you give this Christmas to these families will make a world of difference in their lives.

Toys should be brought to the church and placed in the designated boxes in the church Narthex between now and Friday, December 5, preferably on one of the last two Sundays of this month.

But the office will be open Wednesday through Friday until 5pm the first week of December to accept your gifts. All gifts will be secured until delivery.
